



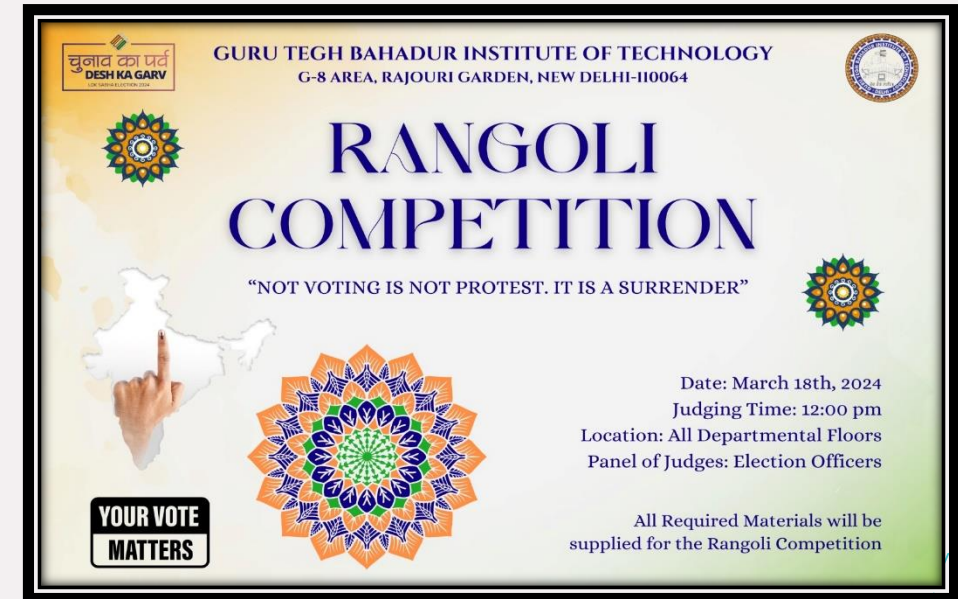
Rangoli Making Competition

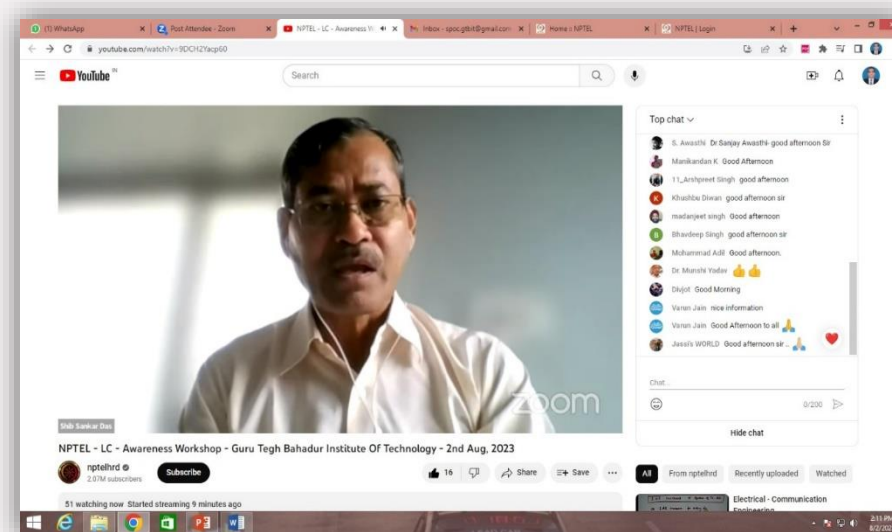
NPTEL Awareness E-Workshop

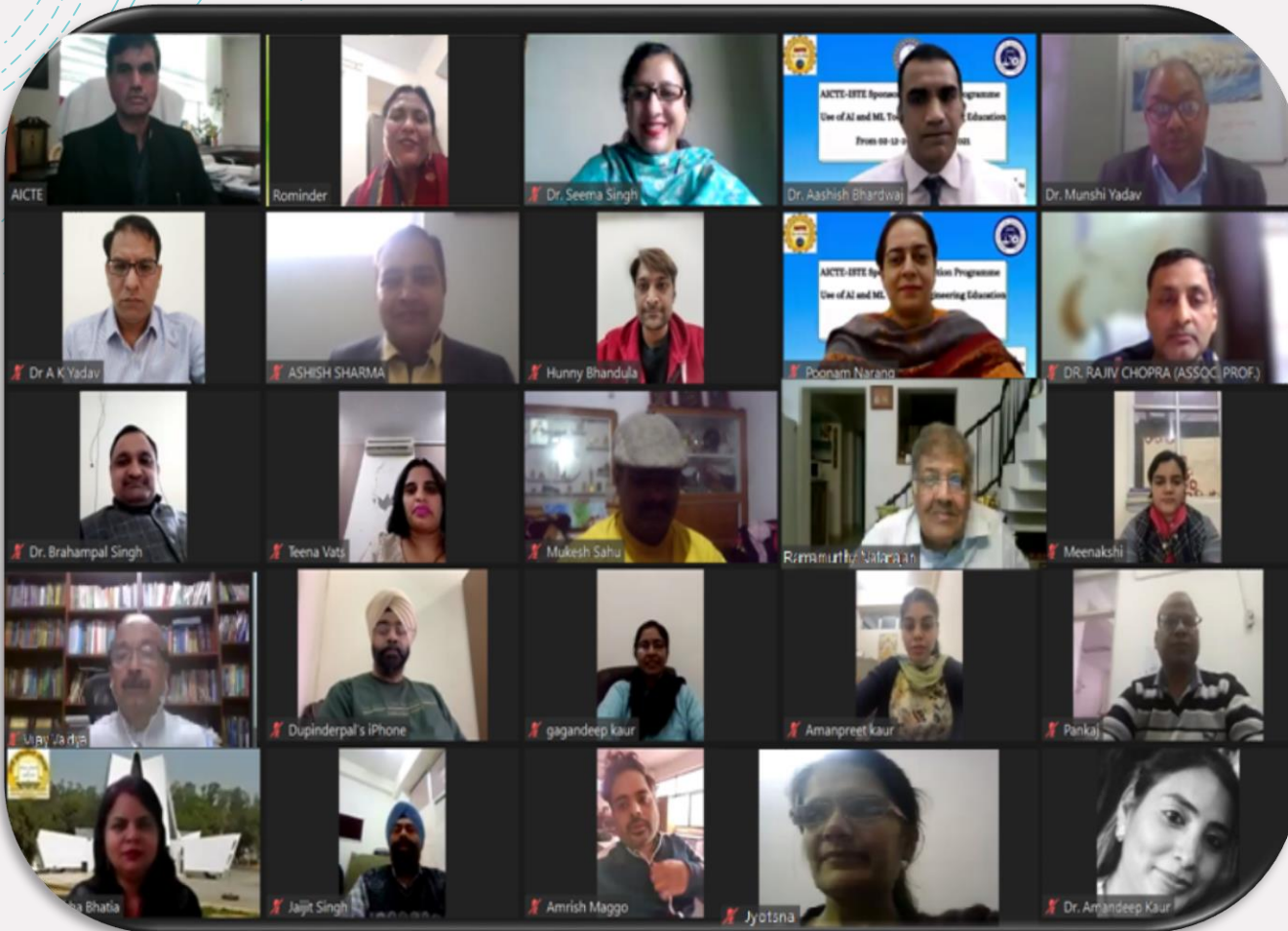

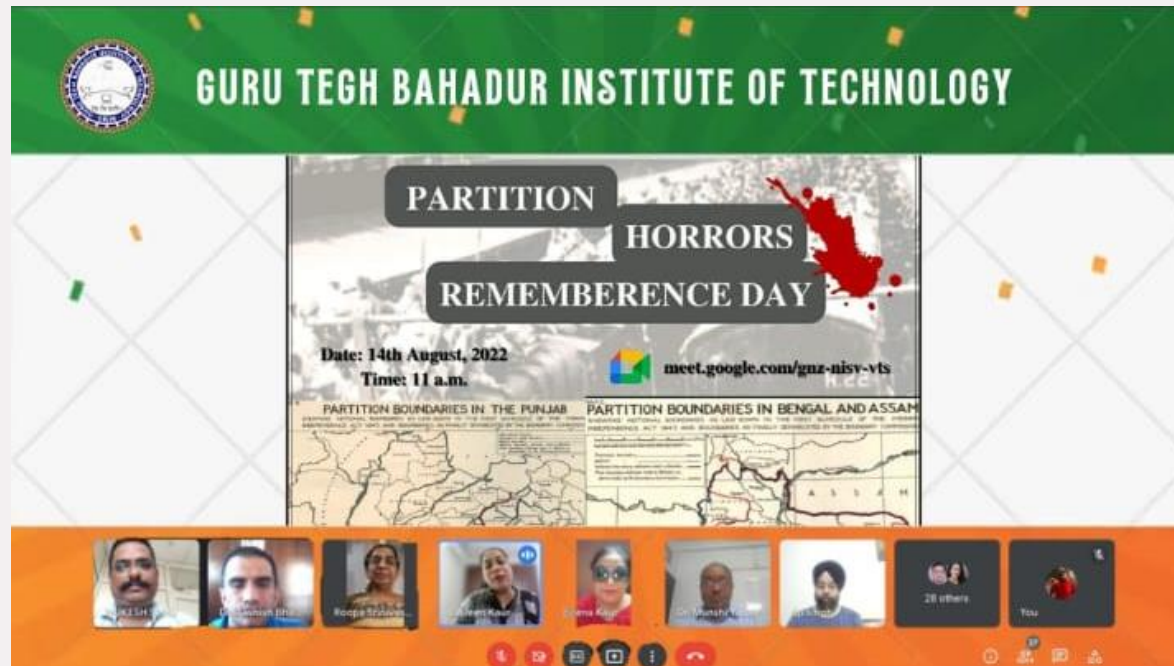


Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav
